
### **About Stridy**

Stridy is a non-profit organisation founded in 2020 that removes litter from our environments through community effort. Stridy enables the community to do this with the Stridy app, which helps track their journeys and connects them with Striders all over the world for a stronger sense of community.

As the only litter-picking developed in South East Asia, Stridy well-positioned to make significant contributions to environmental causes in the region. Stridy fosters a strong sense of community among its users. empowering individuals to take collective action and make a tangible difference in their local environments. Stridy is currently headquartered in Singapore.

## Founder's Note

Thank you for being part of our journey in alleviating the challenges of litter, household waste and recycling.

At Stridy, we are making a contribution by globally mobilizing enthusiasts to pick litter in their own living environments. The Stridy app helps them to keep track of where they have been, how much distance they traversed and what they removed from the environment. In Singapore, where we are based, we also organise group litter clean ups for schools, corporates and institutions. In 2025, we had around 4,500 participants take part in our programs and gained valuable knowledge about how the Singapore community addresses litter, household waste, and recycling.

Stridy is a 'for fun and not for profit' initiative. It is funded by donations and small contributions from our group cleanup activities.

In relatively clean environments like Singapore, individual efforts can have a significant impact. We estimate that approximately 30 new litter items appear on every kilometer of Singaporean walking paths or roadsides each week. This manageable amount can be easily removed by any determined dedicated Strider who goes out cleaning a couple of kilometers every two weeks. By our math, Singapore would be entirely clean if there were just a few thousand dedicated volunteers! This would send a powerful message to the broader community about the shared responsibility we all have in maintaining clean living environments.

We know it can be done. We keep a keen eye on clean up initiatives around the world and know there are many communities that are being kept really clean as a result of the combination of well thought through public waste management infrastructure augmented by volunteers who do their bit. This powerful combination of good policy and civic engagement is something we strive to emulate.

At Stridy, our vision is to see more people actively participating in these types of activities. We aim to support them with a tool that tracks their collective efforts and impact. In 2024, we made notable progress towards that ambition.

We have begun organising our first communities in Singapore, bringing together local waste management companies, public officials, and volunteers. We believe we will be able to show that these initiatives can make a difference.

Equally important, we made significant improvements to our technology. Using our app is now a breeze and together with our dashboard, users can track their individual progress, as well as the progress of their group or other users in their local community.

In 2025 we will be working to create more groundswell. We want to enable those already engaged in their own personal or group litter clean up activities and aim to get more people enthusiastic about helping to keep living environments clean.

This powerful combination of good policy and civic engagement is something we strive to emulate.







The urban cleanup with Stridy enabled students to appreciate the effort put into maintaining a clean estate. The students were very excited in using the tools provided and had a fun time trying to pick up all the litter they saw, ranging from cigarette butts, which the students also noticed as the most frequent litter, to batteries and strings. The debrief session enabled students to consolidate their learning and translate what observed and learnt to the home, school and community. The use of the Stridy App enables students to track the duration spent and the distance covered and more importantly, the amount of litter and type of litter picked. The impact card is also useful in quantifying the impact of the experience.


